


With a standard mouse, the wrist is fully turned, i.e. the palm faces downwards. This is not a natural posture.

Standard button settings

- 1 Top button left click
- Wheel button middle click (pan and rotate in some programs)
- 3 Middle button right click
- 4 Bottom button back
- 5 Thumb button forward





Adjusting speed

Press the button on the bottom until the light is blue.






Windows Install

Before connecting Evoluent Mouse, go to Control Panel, Add or Remove Programs and remove any previous Evoluent Mouse Manager and any other mouse software, except touchpad driver. If there is no mouse software listed, skip this step.

- Before connecting the Evoluent Mouse, go to Control Panel, Mouse, and:
 - 1. Uncheck the box for Swap Primary and Secondary Buttons.
 - (2) Check the box for Enhance Pointer Precision. This is very important.
 - (3) In Pointer Options, set the pointer speed slider to the middle position.
- Insert the USB connector into a USB port directly on the computer.
- If the Add Hardware Wizard appears, do not select Search for Best Driver, but choose Display All Drivers, and select Human Interface Device (HID) Compliant Mouse.
